

# GETTING AHEAD OF THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION

A checklist for Tennessee's immigrant communities:

## KNOW YOUR STATUS

Gather your immigration documents and paperwork and make sure you do not miss any immigration appointments or Immigration Court hearings. Missing an immigration court hearing will lead to a removal order. If you are a DACA status holder, consider filing to renew your status now.

## KNOW YOUR OPTIONS

Talk to a qualified and reputable immigration attorney for a full legal screening. There are multiple ways to find attorneys and resources statewide, one of them being TIRRC's resource line. ## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS WHEN IN CONTACT WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT

Everyone, regardless of their immigration status, has rights in this country. It is important to know the rights you have if you encounter law enforcement while driving, in public, or in your home.
