A checklist for Trans community members in Tennessee:

UPDATE OR OBTAIN YOUR PASSPORT.
This is crucial, as it serves as a valid ID in most places and is necessary for international travel. You can change the gender marker on your passport just by checking a box on a form. This easy process might not be available in 2025, so act now if you need to.
CHANGE YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY OFFICE
GENDER MARKER.
Updating your gender marker with Social Security could help prevent mismatch that might flag your identification within federal systems. The process is straightforward and simple, with their own website explaining which form to complete and where to submit it.
